What do other hospices look like?

A vast majority of other hospices:

- For-Profit
- Parent company is out of state
- Service providers may have to travel long distances to reach patients
- Absence of an in-patient facility
- Can't provide continuity of care
Patients have to be discharged from other hospices in order to be admitted to the Rainey Hospice House
